2010 CHOCOLATES IN RHYME

Chocolates in Rhyme is an event within *Chocolate Winterfest, Latrobe* - a wickedly delicious festival on 11 July celebrating all things chocolate.

AWARD CATEGORIES AND PRIZES

Lower Primary (Kindergarten - Grade 3)	Runner up: \$5.00	Winner: \$10.00 and trophy
Upper Primary (Grades 4-6)	Runner up: \$15.00	Winner: \$30.00 and trophy
Junior Secondary (Grades 7-9)	Runner up: \$25.00	Winner: \$50.00 and trophy
Senior Secondary (Grades 10-12)	Runner up: \$35.00	Winner: \$70.00 and trophy

HOW TO ENTER

1. Write a poem on the theme of "chocolate". Must be no more than 150 words.
2. All entries are to be clearly written or, preferably, typed and fit on the one page.
3. Whilst illustrations and decorations make poems appealing to the public to read, they will not be considered in the judging process.
4. Complete the entry details and include **on the back** of each poem. **Entrants' names must not appear on the front of the poem submitted.**
5. Photocopied entry forms are acceptable. You can also download entry forms from www.chocolatewinterfest.com.au under the Taking Part section.
6. Entries will not be returned so please keep a copy of your poem.
7. No more than two entries will be received from one student.
8. Entries must be forwarded to **reach** Latrobe Council, P O Box 63, Latrobe, 7307 **no later than 4.30 pm on Thursday, 27 May, 2010**. Late entries will not be accepted.
9. The organisers will notify winners as soon as practical after the completion of judging.
10. Ideally, the winning entries may be performed by their author at the presentation of the Chocolates in Rhyme awards, which will be held at the Latrobe RSL, 160 Gilbert Street, Latrobe from 2.30 pm on Sunday, 11 July.

Winners may nominate another poet for such a performance. Alternatively, if winners cannot be present, another poet will present the entry.



CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Award Categories and Prizes and How to Enter form part of the Conditions of Entry.
2. All poems must be the students' own work and not copied or reworded from another poem.
3. Faxed entries will not be accepted.
4. Poems will be judged on originality, imagery, use of language and construction.
5. The judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
6. Latrobe Council reserves the right to have any entry published, reproduced or publicised. All entries will be displayed throughout the town of Latrobe in the lead-up and during *Chocolate Winterfest, Latrobe* whilst Winner, Runner Up and Highly Commended poems will be published on the *Chocolate Winterfest, Latrobe* website.
7. Winning and Runner Up entries will be published in The Sunday Examiner on Sunday, 11 July.
8. Entrants may be asked to assist in media publicity in the form of comments and/or photographs.
